Activities

Thursday, February 9, 2023

Mariners' Museum

9:30 am – noon

19.8 miles from hotel

Approximately 25-minute drive from hotel

Includes 2-hour guided tour, plus unlimited touring of all exhibits, includes boxed lunch.

The Mariners' Museum is one of the largest maritime museums in the world and includes 32,000 objects and artifacts, as well as 110,000 books and 800,000 photographs. The museum is currently preserving the rotating turret from the Monitor, the Union's Civil War ironclad.

American Revolution Museum at Yorktown

9 am – 11 am

10 miles from hotel

Approx. 16-minute drive from hotel

Includes 2-hour guided tour, plus unlimited touring of all exhibits.

This museum traces the history of the American Revolution from Lexington and Concord to the victory and surrender of the British Army in Yorktown in 1781.

Colonial Williamsburg

1:30 pm – 4:45 pm

4.2 miles from hotel

Approx. 11-minute drive from hotel

Approx. 21-minute drive from Yorktown

Approx. 30-minute drive from Mariners' Museum

Includes 1-hour guided tour.

Price includes admission to all buildings.

Colonial Williamsburg is a 300-acre historic area including several hundred restored or recreated buildings from the 18th century. Costumed interpreters depict American colonial life.

Sherwood Forest Plantation

2 pm – 4 pm

24.5 miles from hotel

Approx. 36-minute drive from hotel

Approx. 44-minute drive from Yorktown

Approx. 52-minute drive from Mariners' Museum

Includes guided tour of manor house and grounds and light refreshments.

Sherwood Forest was the home of U.S. President John Tyler with the manor house having been constructed in 1720. It is the longest frame house in America featuring a 68-foot ballroom. It is still occupied by the descendants of President Tyler.
