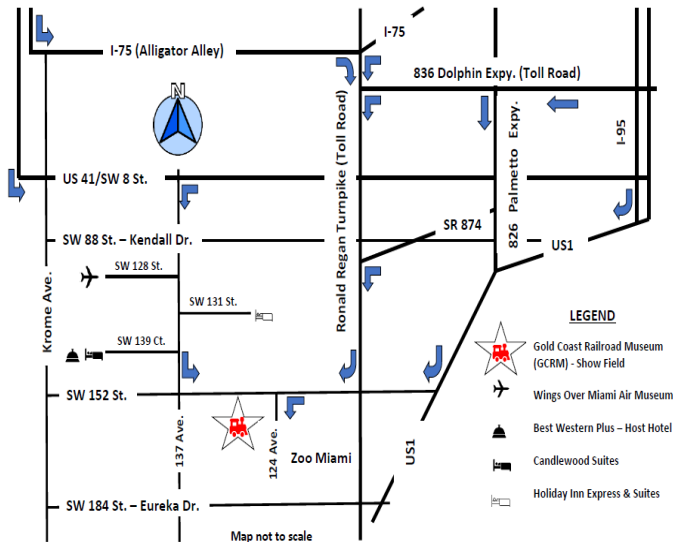

Directions

Coming from the North and West: From all expressways follow signs to Homestead / Florida Keys.

From the Florida (Ronald Reagan) Turnpike take Exit 16 (Coral Reef Dr / SW 152 Street). Head West. Turn left at SW 124 Ave. (Zoo Miami entrance)

From I-75 exit on to 826 South. Exit on to 874. Merge on to the Florida Tpk South and take Exit 16 (Coral Reef Dr / SW 152 Street). Head West. Turn left at SW 124 Ave. (Zoo Miami entrance)

From I-95 South take 836 West to 826 South to 874 then merge on to the Florida Tpk South and take Exit 16 (Coral Reef Dr / SW 152 Street). Head West. Turn left at SW 124 Ave. (Zoo Miami entrance)

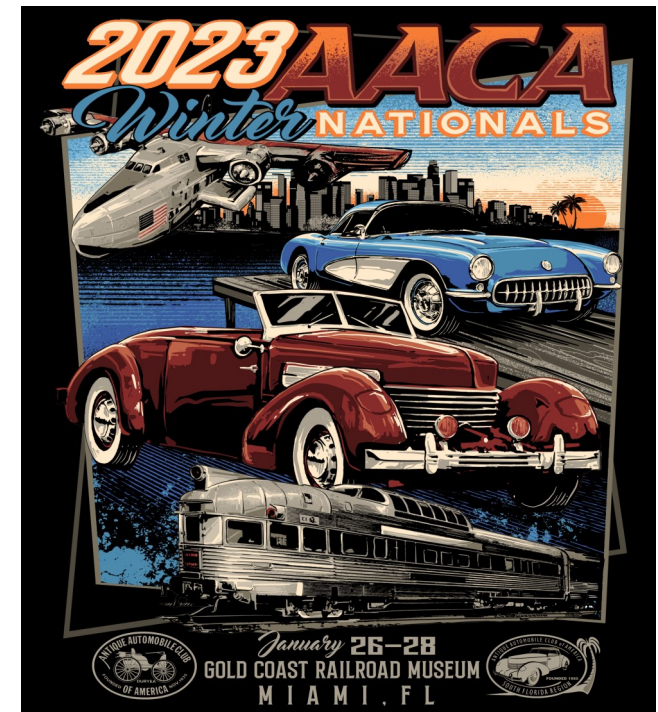
From 826 South exit on to 874 then merge on to the Florida Tpk South and take Exit 16 (Coral Reef Dr / SW 152 Street). Head West. Turn left at SW 124 Ave. (Zoo Miami entrance); **if you miss the 874 exit, continue on 826 where it connects with US 1.**

From US 1 turn right on 152 Street. Head west and turn left on SW 124 Ave. (Zoo Miami entrance)

Coming from the South:

From the Florida Turnpike take Exit 16 (Coral Reef Dr / SW 152 Street). Head West. Turn left at SW 124 Ave. (Zoo Miami entrance)

From US 1 turn left on 152 Street. Head west and turn left on SW 124 Ave. (Zoo Miami entrance)
