Providing Feedback to Owners is My Most Rewarding Job

The 2023 show season is upon us and I'm happy to once again be serving as your Vice President of Judging. I have been involved with judging in AACA for about 20 years and serving AACA in this capacity has truly been an honor.

I must say that I wasn't quite prepared for the number of members who ask for judging

feedback after an event. Last year, I received more than 300 requests for judging sheets. Each one of these owners is looking to improve their vehicles, which is a positive thing. Previous guidelines noted that only owners who did not receive the award

for which they competed were eligible to get their judging sheets. I know that for many years my predecessors have provided feedback to owners regardless of whether an award was won or not. The *Judging Guidelines* this year have been revised to reflect the practice of providing feedback to ANY owner. I would ask that all Team Captains help spread the word that anyone can ask for feedback on their vehicles.

It is my hope that by continuing the practice of providing this feedback that we can continue to help our members improve their restorations. Providing this assistance is one of the most rewarding parts of my role as VP of Judging.

Basic, Advanced & Team Captain Judging Schools to Be Offered More Often

Another year has started, which means that it's time to attend Judging School again. Those of you who were in attendance in Williamsburg, VA, may have noticed a change to the format of our Judging School. Dain King, John Harvey and I worked hard over the winter to divide the schools into three different sessions: Basic, Advanced and Team Captain. This change has

been on my mind for several years and we now have the instructors in place to see that vision come to fruition. Having these three different schools at the Annual Convention is not new. I remember these offerings maybe 15 years ago in Philadelphia. What will be new is that we are planning to continue offering the Basic school for judges with less than 25 credits and the Advanced school for judges with more than 25 credits at most Nationals this year. The Team Captain training will be handled as a CJE class offered after Judges Breakfast.

Our judging system is based on how a vehicle could have been delivered to the first owner. To emphasize that standard, Hulon McCraw and I discussed bringing an old program back to life. If you were in Miami, you might have noticed some brand-new vehicles, prepped for delivery, outside of the Judging School and at the entrance of the show field on Saturday. These cars represent 400-point cars in our judging system. Look for other examples at the Charlotte Nationals and I hope to have arrangements made at other events this year.

I hope that all of you believe that these changes are positive and will move our judging program forward.

Join us for the Southeastern Spring Nationals held at the Charlotte Motor Speedway April 13-15, 2023, showing your car, judging or just seeing the variety of cars on the show field. Judging Schools will be held on Friday afternoon and will feature both the basic and advanced schools. Team Captain training will be offered through a CJE following the Judges Breakfast. Registration packets will be available for pickup beginning Thursday morning in the large tent on the show field. Show participants and judges will receive passes to enter the flea market for free.
