Lake George
9:00am-4:00pm

Enjoy the bus ride as it enters the Adirondack State Park, three times larger than Yosemite. Arrive at Lake George nicknamed the “Queen of the Lakes” ranked as the cleanest lake in the U.S.

You will have your choice of how to spend the day. Enjoy the many shops and restaurants while overlooking at the lake.

Perhaps, a one-hour ride on the 32-mile lake aboard a paddlewheel steamboat and its Calliope or choose a two-hour ride luncheon cruise with entertainment on the Lac du Saint Sacrement.

History your thing. Visit Fort Henry and its museum. The fort was built in 1755 to fight the French Indian War. Wander the grounds on your own or take a tour of the fort.

National Horse Racing Museum and
The Saratoga Winery
8:30am-2:30pm - Bus trip

Founded in 1950, the museum has become a permanent home for the important memorabilia for the sport of horse racing. Start off with a short presentation. Proceed to the signature film “What it Takes: Journey to the Hall of Fame”. This immersive, theatrical film narrated by Bob Costas brings viewers on an amazing journey of the sport. Spend the rest of your time in some of the galleries and interactive stations.

Leave the museum and head to the Saratoga Winery. This restaurant will give you the opportunity to have several options.

Choose one of three wine flights for a generous tasting of 5 wines Not a wine drinker, then choose a beer flight.

Nondrinkers may use their voucher towards the cost of lunch. Sit inside or outside under a covered tent.
