

- 2. Register for judging as soon as you know which Nationals you will be able to attend. Signing up early helps the Chief Judge to set up the best judging teams he/she can. Additionally, the earlier you sign up, the better your chances are that you will receive the judging class you desire.



Finally, remember that each of you serves as an ambassador for the Club. For many of the car owners, the judging team is their only contact with any AACA "official." It is our job as judges to maintain a welcoming, pleasant and professional experience.

What is Documentation?

Page 1-1 of the AACA Official Judging Guidelines states, "The objective of AACA judging is to evaluate an antique vehicle, which has been restored to the same state as the dealer could have prepared the vehicle for delivery to the customer. This includes any feature, option or accessory shown in the original factory catalog, parts book, sales

literature, or company directives for the model year of the vehicle."

Documentation would also include **advertisements** in magazines, many of which were prepared before the actual product introduction. In some cases, errors were made, such as colors that were never produced, including the wrong color for the primary engine. If that is the case, the documentation would have to be accepted. However, if an advertisement for spark plugs is offered up as documentation for stainless steel trim on a production vehicle, when in fact the trim was only on a prototype, it would not satisfy as documentation because the ad was printed to sell the spark plugs, not the automobile. Confusing?

In a 1954 issue of *The Saturday Evening Post*, the Champion Spark Plug Company ran an ad for their new "Turbo Action" spark plugs. The ad featured a prototype 1955 Ford Thunderbird, which had just been introduced. It is easy to tell it is a prototype because it has a copy of the "Fairlane Slash" on the front fender that was so popular on the full-size Fords of 1955 (and 1956). Since the ad was for Champion Spark Plugs, it cannot be considered official Ford documentation.

On the other hand, if perchance a 1955 Ford Thunderbird showed up on the judging field, sporting a "Fairlane Slash" on both front fenders, along with the stainless trim along the centerline, and the owner provided documentation consisting of an ad from *The Saturday Evening Post* showing the same car as advertised by Ford Motor Company, that would be considered sales literature produced by Ford Motor Company. But the subject Thunderbird would have to be in Class 35, not Class 31. Time for a different pile of documentation, but that is for another column at another time.
