

Sunday June 1 (35 miles)

Registration, at the hotel, then a tour of the Seiverling Pedal Car Museum before the opening Banquet



Monday June 2 (47 miles)

Weavertown Coach, Cal High collection, special guided tours of historic Lititz PA



Our day starts with a stop at Weavertown Coach, a company that makes Amish buggies and wagons. From there we visit the incredible car collection of Cal High. In the afternoon we travel to historic Lititz for guided tours of the Johannes Mueller House and the Lititz Moravian Church. Our last stop is the Julius Sturgis pretzel bakery, the oldest commercial pretzel bakery in America!

Tuesday June 3 (62 miles)

Herr's Chips, Robert Fulton birthplace, Rock Ford Plantation



Today we head South and start with a tour of the Herr's potato chip factory. Then we stop at the birthplace of Robert Fulton, the father of the Steamship. Our last stop is the restored home of Gen. Edward Hand, a General in the Continental Army during the American Revolution

Wednesday June 4 (9 miles)

Wednesday is Train Day!



First stop is a guided tour of the Railroad Museum of PA, followed by lunch on a real dining car and then a ride on the Strasburg Railroad! Finish the tour day with a stop at the amazing Choo Choo Barn model train layout.

Thursday June 5 (45 miles)

Wheatland and Ephrata Cloisters



We start the day at the home of President James Buchanan and the Lancaster Historical society. We then wind our way through Lancaster and drive past the tomb of President Buchanan. After lunch we have a guided tour of the Ephrata Cloisters before heading back to the hotel

Friday June 6 (30 miles)

Hans Herr House and Barry's Car barn



Our last day is a short day. We start at the Hans Herr House, the oldest structure in Lancaster County. After our guided tour there, we will make an optional stop for lunch on your own at the Willow Street Restaurant (2.5 miles away).

After lunch we tour Barry's Car barn in Intercourse. From there a quick trip back to the hotel to rest, pack and prepare for the closing banquet.
