2025 AACA SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Eligibility and Application Procedures

GENERAL GUIDELINES:

- **Deadline for all applications shall be December 1, of the year preceding the AACA Annual Conference.**
- **NOTE:** Some scholarships require the applicant to be a member of Antique Automobile Club of America. Take note, as others may also allow the applicant to have a current member of your immediate family* or legal guardian in the AACA who are active and in good standing for a minimum of 5 years prior to the scholarship deadline date, or be an active AACA member in good standing for a minimum of 24 continuous months prior to the scholarship deadline date. *** Immediate family means father, mother or grandparent.**
- **OFFICIAL High School/College Transcript** is defined as a signed and sealed record produced by your school's Registrar. It can be included in your packet and sent by Certified Mail to the Scholarship AACA VP; or sent directly from your school to the Chair by regular mail. Note: Opened transcripts, not in an official signed and sealed envelope, are invalid and unofficial and will not be accepted.
- **Write and Include a Student Essay** that includes and describes qualities that should be mentioned, such as: both interest in antique automobiles and growing development in AACA /the vintage car hobby; factors that have influenced interest in antique vehicles; and activities in local club, typed or handwritten clearly (one page only).
- **Write and Include a Student Resume/Profile** that includes and describes qualities that support: academic area of greatest strength; career objective; honors received; outstanding projects or papers; involvement in community activities; extra-curricular activities; special skills, talents, hobbies and other interests; special skills, talents, hobbies and other interests) about your education and vocational goals.
- **Include one/two letters of recommendation from different AACA members who are not a close relative.** Those requested for the letter should mention and include describing the candidate in clear and concise terms, the candidate's personal characteristics, and include appropriate comments on the candidate's achievement and involvement in the auto hobby plus describe both their involvement with and how long they have been acquainted with the candidate.
- **Include a .jpeg photo** or a non-returnable wallet-sized recent photo for possible use by the AACA. By submitting a photo, the AACA reserves the right to use the submitted photo in publications concerning the scholarship unless a specific written objection to said use is included when the photo is submitted.
- When indicated, **BOTH the affiliated Region/Chapter President AND Secretary** must verify membership of applicant or of immediate family by completing and signing the last section of this application.
- **Applications must be typed or handwritten clearly and ALL requirements and questions**

must be completed and answered or the application will be disqualified. An online application is available at www.aaca.org. Your application and all supplementary material become the property of the AACA and cannot be returned. You are encouraged to make a photocopy of your application before submission.

- Final Scholarship Selection: Selection will be made by the AACA Scholarship Review Committee.
- Announcement of the Awards: Each award shall be presented in conjunction with the AACA National Awards as a part of the AACA Annual Convention, held in the first quarter of each year.

- **IMPORTANT – In order to avoid disqualification, please use each Award's Applicant Checklist of items that must be included with your application for each scholarship.**

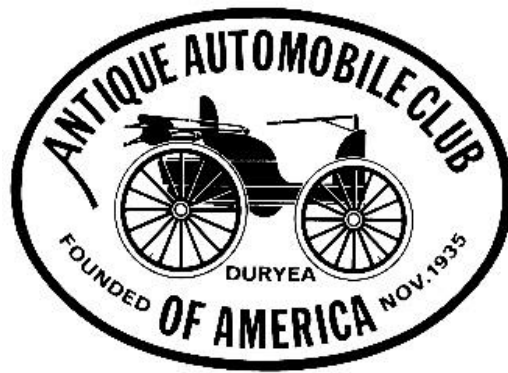
